

Flu clinics are generally held during the month of October to December where Chronic Disease patients with diabetes, asthma and other chronic diseases are recommended to have the vaccination.

Patients aged 65 years and over are also recommended to have their flu vaccination.

Cervical Smears

All women over the age of 25 years should have a cervical smear. Please make an appointment with the Practice Nurse when your cervical smear is due or you need advice regarding this test.
